## Call for Partnerships – Global Media Defence Fund (GMDF)

### Objective:

The objective of this Call for Partnerships is to provide financial support to local, regional, and global projects that strengthen the legal protection of journalists and/or combat impunity for violence, threats, and attacks against them, in line with international standards.

### Eligibility:

Eligible applicants are not-for-profit organizations with at least two years of legal existence, proven experience in human rights, media, or freedom of expression projects, and the technical and administrative capacity to implement international initiatives. They must demonstrate a commitment to gender equality, inclusion, and diversity, and be able to document concrete results and impact.

Priority will be given to proposals that promote inter-regional collaboration and sustainable outcomes.

### Funding:

Grants range from USD 15,000 to USD 50,000, depending on the scale and complexity of the proposed action. The total indicative budget available for this Call is USD 800,000, to be distributed among the highest-scoring proposals. All partners must provide at least 5% co-funding (monetary or in-kind). Only direct project-related costs are eligible; overhead or indirect costs are not covered.

## International Development Grant

### Objective:

To increase opportunities for individuals and organizations for the development and/or dissemination of behavior analysis internationally.

### Eligibility:

All applicants must be: (1) formally affiliated with a university or institution; (2) not currently in receipt of a SABA International Development Grant

### Funding:

The amount awarded will vary from US\$1,000 up to US\$5,000 each to individuals or organizations interested in developing behavior analysis internationally. All expenses must be clearly detailed in the proposed budget statement. Up to four grants will be awarded annually.

In addition, the top-scoring grant winner from outside the United States may be eligible for a travel grant of up to US\$1,000 to allow them to present at the annual convention. The grant will be provided after the convention and is contingent upon the grantee's presence and presentation.

## International funding for climate action projects

### Objective:

IKI Small Grants is implemented by the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH and provides funding in two lines: International Calls and Funding Institutions. Both fund non-profit projects and initiatives that address the four IKI support areas: mitigation of greenhouse gas emissions, adaptation to the impacts of climate change, conservation of natural carbon sinks/REDD+, and conservation of biodiversity.

### Eligibility:

The programme is aimed at regional, national, and local organizations based in countries eligible for Official Development Assistance (ODA).

### Funding:

It offers technical support and institutional strengthening, access to the global IKI network of climate and environmental projects, international visibility and cooperation opportunities, as well as training processes in project management, monitoring, and safeguards, with funding ranging from €60,000 to €200,000 and a duration of 1 to 3 years.

## UNESCO-Hamdan Prize for Teacher Development

### Objective :

The UNESCO-Hamdan Prize for Teacher Development was created in 2008 to support the improvement of teaching and learning quality toward achieving Sustainable Development Goal 4 on education, one of UNESCO's priorities.

### Elegibility:

The following organizations, active in the field of teaching and learning, are eligible to apply:

- International or national organizations and institutions
- Governmental or non-governmental organizations
- Educational or research institutions

Projects by individuals are not eligible and will not be considered.

### Funding :

Three winning projects will be selected, each receiving US\$100,000 in funding.

## Mitigation Action Facility 2026: Funding for Climate Mitigation Projects

### Objective:

The Mitigation Action Facility is a global platform that finances transformative projects aimed at accelerating decarbonization in countries eligible for Official Development Assistance, including Colombia. The 2026 call seeks to identify innovative, implementation-ready initiatives capable of delivering systemic change across three priority sectors: energy, transport, and industry.

### Eligibility:

The call is open to a broad range of stakeholders from the District and the wider community, including public entities, development banks, private-sector organizations, NGOs, universities, companies, foundations, and other actors engaged in climate-mitigation efforts. Eligible applicants must demonstrate the institutional capacity, technical expertise, and strategic alignment required to implement transformative decarbonization actions.

### Funding:

Funding is allocated based on the project's quality, feasibility, and potential for impact. The program supports multi-year initiatives and prioritizes scalable models that strengthen local systems and community resilience. Funding amounts vary according to the project's design, scope, and demonstrated need.

## Collaborative Research Grants

### Objective :

The aim of the collaborative research grant is to assist researchers in developing new projects which will be pursued through the collaboration with one or more researchers from different countries. In particular, collaborative research are intended to support preliminary research which may assist the holders to subsequently obtain larger scale funding from other sources (for full members)

### Eligibility:

Collaborative grants are exclusively available to full EASP members, and both partners must hold active membership. Each member may receive only one collaborative grant within a five-year period. At least one partner must be based in a country facing economic hardship or where EASP has limited representation.

### Funding :

The maximum grant awarded to any proposal will typically not exceed €5000 and will be used to compensate participants, purchase consumables or other equipment, and travel costs.

## Convocatoria 2026 - Premios Nacionales de Ciencias

### Objetivo:

Incentivar, promover y difundir la investigación científica e innovación en las áreas de: Ciencias Exactas, Físicas y Naturales, Ciencias Sociales y Humanas y Medio Ambiente y Desarrollo Sostenible, a través del otorgamiento de un premio representado en una suma de dinero, una medalla de plata y un diploma.

### Dirigido a:

La convocatoria está abierta únicamente a personas naturales y de nacionalidad colombiana de conformidad con lo establecido en la Constitución Política y las leyes colombianas.

### Financiación:

El Premio está representado en una medalla de plata con el perfil de Don Alejandro Ángel Escobar, un diploma y una suma de dinero, la cual será desembolsada únicamente a nombre del titular en el caso de postulaciones individuales, en el caso de los colectivos al Coordinador o Representante, quien siempre y en todo caso se deberá tratar de una persona natural de nacionalidad colombiana.

## Wellcome Career Development Awards

### Objective :

To support mid-career researchers with the potential to become international research leaders by funding innovative research programmes that advance understanding of human life, health, and wellbeing.

### Eligibility:

Applicants must:

- Be mid-career researchers with independent research experience.
- Have made significant contributions to their field.
- Commit at least 80% of their time to the project.
- Be hosted by a non-profit organisation

### Funding :

Duration: Usually up to 8 years.

Annual budget: Typically below £250,000 per year

## 28th Call for Proposals Thriving Farmers, Resilient Ecosystems, Empowered Communities

### Objective :

To contribute to poverty alleviation by strengthening the income-generating capacity of commodity producers and mitigating vulnerability to their economic well being.

### Elegibility:

SMEs, cooperatives, NGOs, social enterprises, and public or private entities operating in CFC member countries may apply. Projects must be financially viable, improve smallholder livelihoods, and applicants must have at least 3 years of operational experience.

### Funding :

Three winning projects will be selected, each receiving US\$100,000 in funding.

## Discovery Research Future Leaders Fellowship



### Objective:

To fund and support outstanding early-career researchers by offering a platform that allows them to broaden their scientific horizons, strengthen their research independence, and develop strong leadership within the field of cardiovascular research.

### Eligibility:

- Early-career researchers who demonstrate exceptional potential in cardiovascular science and are seeking opportunities to expand their international training, enhance their professional development, and advance toward an independent research career.

### Funding:

- Training fund: up to £3,000 per award for workshops, training, or coaching.
- Travel fund: up to £4,000 per award for attending or presenting at scientific meetings.
- Care-related expenses: up to £800 per award for costs associated with caring responsibilities during fellowship activities.

## Breast Cancer Research Foundation-AACR Career Development Awards

### Objective:

To promote and support innovative breast cancer research led by early-career investigators. The program aims to accelerate scientific progress by funding projects with direct applicability and relevance to breast cancer, whether basic, translational, clinical, epidemiological, or population-based.

### Elegibility:

- Hold a doctoral degree (PhD, MD, MD/PhD, or equivalent).
- Hold a faculty-level position (assistant professor, instructor, research assistant professor, or equivalent) by July 1, 2026.
- Have started their first independent faculty position within the past 6 years (not before July 1, 2020).
- Have independent laboratory space and work at an academic, medical, or research institution anywhere in the world (no citizenship restrictions).

### Funding:

Each award provides \$150,000 over two years to cover:

- Salary and benefits of the PI and research collaborators or trainees.
- Research/laboratory supplies and equipment.
- Graduate student tuition.
- Publication fees related to the project.
- Other research-related expenses.

## OAS Scholarship and Training Programs

### Objective:

The OAS Scholarship and Training Programs within the Department of Human Development Education and Employment of the Executive Secretariat for Integral Development offers scholarships for undergraduate and graduate-level studies, short-term professional training courses and innovative online training opportunities for citizens/permanent residents of the OAS Member States. Its goal is to increase access to affordable quality higher education for citizens of the Americas and support member states.

### Eligibility:

To be considered for this scholarship opportunity, an applicant must: - Provide an unconditional admission letter to AUWCL - This scholarship opportunity is open to new applicants to AUWCL who are from an OAS member state, except the United States, and are not for current OAS-AUWCL scholarship recipients. - Be a citizen and/or permanent legal resident of any OAS member state, except the United States.

### Funding:

The OAS Academic Scholarship Program (ASP) which offers scholarships of up to USD \$10,000 per academic year for the pursuit of master's Degrees, Doctoral Degrees, and Graduate Research leading to a graduate degree; and for the last two years of undergraduate studies solely to citizens and residents of the English-speaking Caribbean and Suriname.
