Kinship Conservation Fellowship: Global Leadership for Sustainability

Objective:

The Kinship Conservation Fellowship aims to strengthen the capacities of leaders who integrate environmental conservation with sustainable economic models. Through mentorship, workshops, and collaborative work, participants develop market-based solutions to real-world challenges in their communities.

Elegibility:

We're looking for conservation leaders with at least five years of on the ground experience in conservation, who are involved with the implementation of market-based approaches to solve environmental problems and ready to be part of an expanding community of global leaders.

Funding:

- Fully funded scholarship valued at USD 8,000.
- Accommodation, meals, and learning materials included.
- Access to an international alumni network of over 300 fellows from 60 countries.
- Specialized training in environmental economics, leadership, and applied sustainability.

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Keeling curve prize

Objective :

The Keeling Curve Prize (KCP) is an international initiative that recognizes projects delivering concrete solutions to the climate crisis. Each year, Climate Curve awards USD 25,000 to ten outstanding projects that reduce greenhouse gas emissions or strengthen environmental resilience. This global call aims to spotlight innovative ideas from any region of the world—including Latin America—with measurable and scalable impact.

Eligibility:

Eligibility criteria

- Projects must be currently underway or at an advanced stage of implementation.
- Demonstrated impact on greenhouse gas emission reductions or climate change mitigation.
- Clear potential for scalability and long-term sustainability.
- Applications must be submitted in English through the official online portal.

Funding :

USD 25,000 award for each of the 10 selected winners.

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Maestrías en diferentes áreas en China

Objetivo :

Mediante el convenio suscrito entre el Gobierno de la República Popular China y el Gobierno de Colombia, se ofrece la oportunidad a profesionales colombianos de realizar estudios de maestría en diferentes áreas, en universidades y centros de enseñanza superior en China.

Dirigido a:

El aspirante debe ser mayor de 20 años y menor de 35 años, tener promedio mínimo de notas de pregrado de 3,8/5,0; contar preferiblemente con mínimo 1 año de experiencia profesional (es decir, luego de haber obtenido el título universitario) en el área del programa a realizar y gozar de buena salud física y mental. El aspirante deberá certificar nivel de mandarín HSK3 y/o nivel de inglés (únicamente son válidos resultados de IELTS o TOEFL) de acuerdo con lo exigido por la universidad a la cual aplique y el programa de interés.

Financiación:

Matrícula

Alojamiento (residencia universitaria o subsidio de alojamiento)

Seguro médico integral: ¥800 por persona al año.

Estipendio mensual: ¥3.000 (mes).

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AI for Forecasting and Sound Reasoning

Objective :

AI for forecasting: We are looking for proposals for AI models that help to make forecasts more accurate or more relevant. We are primarily interested in probabilistic, judgmental forecasting, i.e. quantitative forecasts that cannot be based fully on large sets of structured data.

Elegibility:

The call is open to a broad range of projects and applicants worldwide. Eligible applicants include nonprofit and for-profit organizations (including academic institutions) as well as individuals, with a preference for nonprofit organizations. Applicants at any career stage and organizations at any level of development may apply, provided they demonstrate relevant experience, which can take many forms and does not require traditional academic credentials. There are no geographic restrictions, although legal or logistical constraints in certain locations may affect the ability to provide funding.

Funding :

We plan to make grants totaling around \$8-10 million for proposals received until January 30, 2026, and expect that in this period, the typical successful proposal will receive funding in the range of \$100,000 to \$1 million for a project duration between 6 months and 2 years.

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Awards for Advancing Minority Mental Health



Objective:

To recognize community-based organizations that advance innovative initiatives to improve awareness, access, and quality of mental health care for underserved minority communities.

Eligibility:

Mental health and well-being organizations, as well as programs that focus on raising awareness of mental health conditions in underserved minority communities including early recognition, treatment availability, access pathways, and cultural barriers to care are eligible to apply. Eligible initiatives must aim to expand access to high quality mental health services and improve the quality of care for underserved minority populations, particularly those within public health systems or living with severe mental illness. Applicants must have been operating for at least two years. Previous award recipients are not eligible unless applying with a new initiative, achievement, or program.

Funding:

Recipients of the Awards for Advancing Minority Mental Health will receive an award check in the amount of \$5,000, a plaque acknowledging their receipt of this award, and recognition in APA and APAF publications and websites. In addition, award recipients and their programs will be recognized at a APAF event during the APA Annual Meeting.

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Convocatoria de Proyectos Sociales

Objetivo:

Dirigido a:

Las entidades que pueden presentarse a la convocatoria son:

- Entidades sin ánimo de lucro.
- Entidades de la economía social que, tengan o no ánimo de lucro, entre las finalidades indicadas en sus estatutos conste explícitamente como su objetivo principal la cohesión social o el interés social y/o cultural.

Financiación:

Los proyectos que se presenten a esta convocatoria podrán solicitar ayudas por un importe de hasta:

- 50.000 €

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Memorial Grants



Objective:

These grants directly promote conservation research. Grants are one-year, unrestricted funds that can be used for direct or indirect costs, including salary. Specific grants may be restricted to certain taxa or new research initiatives. Please note, you must carefully describe how this grant may impact grassland conservation efforts in your application.

Eligibility:

Latin American researchers affiliated with a university, museum, or conservation organization. Preference is given to researchers who have participated in the Student Grant or Research Equipment programs and who have submitted final reports.

Funding:

Projects are financed between USD 2.000 and USD 10.000 per year.

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International funding for climate action projects

Objective:

To engage subject matter expert (SME) consultants to support CRDF Global's NIH-funded research programs by providing specialized technical review of research proposals, progress reports, and final technical reports in areas related to infectious diseases, immunology, and global health. The objective is to ensure scientific quality, relevance, and compliance with program requirements through expert assessment and peer-review participation.

Eligibility:

The call is open to individual consultants with demonstrated expertise in infectious diseases, immunology, and related fields such as TB, HIV, cancer, hepatitis, vaccines, maternal health, infection prevention and control, and health systems strengthening. Applicants at all career stages may apply, provided they have relevant experience in proposal evaluation, technical reporting, and participation in expert review panels. Prior experience in virtual or international review settings is preferred.

Funding:

Selected consultants are compensated by CRDF Global, within the framework of NIH-supported research programs. SMEs receive a stipend of USD 100 per proposal or technical/final report reviewed, with tasks assigned on an ad hoc basis throughout the review period.

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Fundación para la Promoción de la Investigación y la Tecnología

Objetivo:

El propósito principal de la Fundación lo constituye el fomento y la promoción de investigaciones científicas que realicen profesionales colombianos o extranjeros que sean residentes. En desarrollo de estas líneas de política, la Fundación para la Promoción de la Investigación y la Tecnología concentra su actividad en el sector de los proyectos científicos de menor tamaño. También, y en la medida en que ello sea posible, se financia parcialmente la participación como ponentes, de científicos al servicio del país, en congresos y seminarios de muy reconocido nivel académico.

Dirigido a:

- Haber cursado estudios superiores y tener título académico.
- Se prefiere a investigadores que hayan hecho algún tipo de publicaciones sobre sus investigaciones.
- Estar vinculado, preferiblemente, a un centro docente, o de investigación, de reconocida idoneidad.
- Estar, preferiblemente, residenciado en Colombia.

Financiación:

El monto máximo a financiar es de COP 20.000.000.

Fecha de cierre:

Abierta permanentemente.

Los proyectos se revisan en enero, marzo, mayo, julio, septiembre y noviembre.

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Objective:

The Rufford Foundation funds nature conservation projects in emerging or developing economy countries. Projects can focus on particular species, threatened habitats or issues like human-wildlife conflict or community education.

For projects focusing on species, we consider work on any NOT listed as Least Concern at a global level in the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species. We also consider species that do not appear on the list because they have not been assessed but are thought to be globally threatened.

Eligibility:

- Applicants should be in the early stages of their conservation careers. Our priority is funding those undertaking an MSc or PhD (or equivalent) or who have graduated from such studies in the past 3 years.
- Projects must have a nature conservation focus.
- Applicants must be working in an eligible country.

Benefits:

The Rufford Foundation provides a staged funding process with four types of grants. In sequence, these are:

- 1st Rufford Small Grant (up to £7,000).
- 2nd Rufford Small Grant (up to £8,000).
- Booster Grant (up to £12,000)
- Completion Grant (up to £18,000)
